DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

Christopher Newport College has established a Distinguished Service Award which will be selectively given to persons who have made an outstanding contribution to the development of the College. The award consists of a bronze medallion suspended from a blue and white ribbon. The medallion is a replica of the College seal. Recipients are:



H. Westcott Cunningham was born in Elizabeth, New Jersey, on June 12, 1921. He graduated from the Pingry School and the College of William and Mary. At William and Mary he was President of the Student Body and played varsity football and track. During World War II, he was the Commanding Officer of a P.T. Boat in the Southwest Pacific. From 1946-1951 Mr. Cunningham was Secretary to the Committee on Admissions at William and Mary, graduate student at William and Mary and the University of Michigan, and English Instructor at William and Mary. He was the Dean of Admissions at the College of William and

Mary from 1953-1961, and served as the first President of Christopher Newport College from 1961-1970. At the present time Mr. Cunningham is the Head Master at The Pingry School, Elizabeth, New Jersey.

Mr. Cunningham is married to Cecil Cary Waddell of Gloucester, Virginia.



Lewis A. McMurran, Jr. was born in Newport News, Virginia on April 11, 1914. He was educated at Washington and Lee University, and served in the Navy during World War II. Mr. McMurran has served as a member of the House of Delegates since 1948. He is the Chairman of the Committee on Roads and Internal Navigation, and serves on the Privileges and Elections, Appropriations, and Rules Committees. In addition, he serves on the Legislative Process, Public Buildings, and Budget Advisory Board Commissions. Other responsibilities include: Chairman, Peninsula Industrial Committee; President, Jamestown Corporation; Chairman,

Virginia Advisory Legislative Council; Secretary and Director, Citizens Rapid Transit Company; and Director, Bank of Virginia-Peninsula.

Mr. McMurran is married to Edith Margaret Lea of Prince Edward Island, Canada.
