Re: Degree Requirements

The Liberal Learning Council recommends the following degree study requirements for students entering beginning Fall 2006.

Bachelor of Arts

Because the Liberal Learning Core contains courses directly related to the Bachelor of Arts degree, the Liberal Learning Council recommends that the University-level degree studies requirements for the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Music and Professional Degrees be eliminated.

Professional Degrees include BSBA, BA with major in Social Work, and BSIS

Students pursuing the Bachelor of Science degree must complete the Investigating the Natural World Area of Inquiry requirement and one sequence from the list below. No more than three of the four BS degree lecture courses may be from the same discipline. No more than two laboratory courses may be from the same discipline. Departments may specify the particular sequence to be taken.
