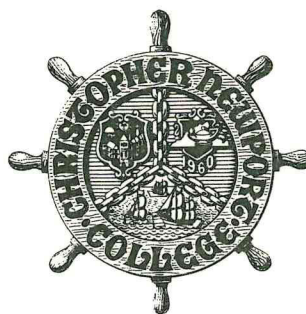

The Distinguished Service Award



Edna Prince Carney

On the occasion of her retirement, the Rector and the members of the Board of Visitors have voted to present the Distinguished Service Award to Mrs. Edna Prince Carney. The award, a bronze medallion of the college seal, was established in 1973 to honor those persons who have made an outstanding contribution to Christopher Newport College or who have made significant achievements through their fields of endeavor.

A native of Virginia and long-time resident of Newport News, Mrs. Carney has been associated with Christopher Newport College since its beginnings in the old John W. Daniel school building on 32nd Street in downtown Newport News. Hired by H. Westcott Cunningham, the first president, Mrs. Carney assisted with the preparation of the initial materials which were necessary to open and operate the college.

She was present on the eighteenth day of September, 1961, when the college bell rang for the first time to summon the eight faculty members and the one hundred and seventy-nine students to their first class at CNC. In those days, when the administrative and support staff numbered only six persons, Mrs. Carney handled a multitude of tasks. In addition to her reception and secretarial duties, she assisted the Registrar, duplicated materials, and operated the switchboard.

During her sixteen year tenure at the college as confidential secretary to the two presidents, Mrs. Carney has been admired and respected for her warm personality and high standards of excellence. She is a worthy recipient of this Distinguished Service Award for her outstanding service to Christopher Newport College.
