Help Fear 2 Freedom Provide Care Kits for Victims of Sexual Assault on Tuesday, November 4 at 6 p.m.

On Tuesday, November 4, the global nonprofit organization Fear 2 Freedom (F2F) will partner with the CNU community to raise awareness of sexual assault and benefit victims throughout our region. The "Celebration Night" event will be held at 6 p.m. in the David Student Union Ballroom.

Participants will help assemble hundreds of "F2F" kits, or rape recovery kits, to be distributed to area hospitals to meet the immediate physical and emotional needs of those affected by sexual assault. The kits provide clothing and basic toiletries, as victims' clothing is often kept as evidence, as well as personal notes of encouragement written by CNU students.

Led by Rosemary Tribble, F2F is dedicated to bringing hope and healing to those wounded by sexual abuse. Its mission is to redeem and restore lives broken by abuse, and educate and empower colleges and communities to work to prevent the sexual abuse crisis. F2F helps educate and empower students about sexual assault, and mobilize them to become part of the solution. In 2014, Virginia Governor Terry McAuliffe appointed Tribble to the Governor's Task Force on Combating Campus Sexual Violence.
