

## **Draft Motion: University Instruction Development Committee**

Whereas teaching is a hallmark of the institution as evinced by University and Departmental Eval-4s;

Whereas there is no university-wide body dedicated solely to the developmental and formative work faculty teaching;

Whereas the IDEA survey is the one consistent measure of classroom instruction used on campus;

Whereas a team of faculty, administrators and staff have been trained to use the IDEA survey as formative tool;

Because faculty development is central to the university and the Faculty Senate's mission and goals;

The Faculty Senate recommends the formation of a permanent university-level committee dedicated to instructional development.

### **Membership:**

- Two tenured faculty members from each of the three colleges
- Provost, ex officio
- Associate Provost, ex officio
- Deans of A&H, NBS and SS, ex officio
- Director, University Assessment and Evaluation, ex officio

### **Charges:**

- To act as a resource for individual faculty and departments
- To explain the IDEA instrument as a formative tool
- To interpret individual surveys and survey sets as formative documents
