Spring Break Housing Information (Read Me First)

Main Campus Residence Halls and Warwick Suites are officially closed for Spring Break, 12 noon Saturday, February 27 until 12 noon Sunday, March 7*. (*The Halls DO NOT reopen at noon on Saturday, March 6 as previously indicated in the Residence Life Handbook). Students wishing to stay for the break must make arrangements to stay with friends off campus or in CNU Apartments/Village or Greek Village (with all roommates' approval). Exceptions are granted for students who are REQUIRED to stay for academic, athletic or CNU employment reasons, however the student MUST be registered (see registration link below). Off-campus employment does not warrant an exception but may be considered.

Other requests for special approval to stay on campus due to extenuating circumstances (including off campus employment) are subject to Spring Break Housing fees (\$100/wk). Requests for special approval must be emailed to Reslife@cnu.edu by 5:00pm Thursday, February 25. Approval is not guaranteed.

Although campus offices including University Police remain open during the break, main campus Front Desk Assistants, RAs and Police Aides will not be on-duty during the break. (East Campus Staff will be on-duty during the break.) Residents who stay are responsible for themselves, are "ON THEIR HONOR" and agree to abide by all Residence Life and University policies. Residents who stay must not prop ANY doors or allow ANYONE else to enter the building. No guests, visitors or other residents are allowed in the building during break. Anyone who violates policy or this trust may be immediately removed for the remainder of break and face judicial charges.

Staff will enter rooms to conduct closing inspections and ongoing maintenance will continue during break.

Spring Break Housing Registration...

Register for Spring Break Housing <u>ONLY</u> if you are REQUIRED to be here for academic, athletic or CNU employment reasons, or, you have received an exception/special approval. If you are unsure whether you are required to be here for break, consult your professor, coach or CNU employer.

You must register by 5:00pm Friday, February 26 to be counted and eligible for Spring Break Housing.
